# Harvest of 2019 From the 9th of September until 10th of October

An extremely challenging year and accentuate by the continual change of the weather conditions, demanding increased attention from the viticulture team on the control of diseases and pests in the vineyard. During the vegetative period, fortunately, moderate temperatures contributed to the late ripening of the berries, which naturally delayed the start of the harvest when compared to the last 5 years, putting the date of the beginning of the harvest at the right time. The grapes were always in excellent condition, showing an excellent balance between sugar and acidity, resulting in very fresh wines, with great aromatic intensity, with high structure, complexity, depth and high precision,

This wine surprises for its purity and sophistication. It results from the perfect balance of the main grape varieties of Quinta Nova de Nossa Senhora do Carmo: Touriga Nacional, Touriga Franca, Tinta Roriz and Tinta Cão, a beautiful composition for the simplicity and transparency of our *terroir*.

Its intense color stimulates individual memory and refers to the immense vineyard and the rugged landscape of the Douro terraces. A wide journey of flavours manifests itself through the density and strength of aromas, cheerful and seductive, with a more sophisticated side ceded by the good French oak wood. In evidence closes with a muscular structure and a succulent texture that intertwined with the body of the wine and make it end tense, long and deep.
