The Quinta Nova de Nossa Senhora do Carmo produced its first wine, and first vintage wine, in 1992. It's the concentration, structure and robustness that define a great Vintage, highlighting the magnificent *terroir* of the Quinta Nova de Nossa Senhora do Carmo, based on careful winemaking and refined ageing. Always wines with considerable tension, they can nonetheless strike a wonderful balance between muscle and gravity, offering long and precise finishes. Bottled in 2019.
